

Learn to Hook Rugs – A Workshop for Beginners

Have you admired handmade hooked rugs at craft shows? Do you appreciate the old hooked rugs sold by antique dealers? Do you relate to magazine articles showing homes decorated with hooked rugs on the floor and on walls? If the answer is “Yes” then this beginners’ workshop may be for you. Attend and learn how to create your own family heirlooms.

On Thursday, August 12, 2010 the Hunterdon County Rug Artisans Guild (HCRAAG) will sponsor a workshop on learning to hook rugs. The workshop will run from 9 am to 12 pm and will be held at the Educational Services Commission (ESC) School at 1422 Rt. 179 about two miles outside of Lambertville, NJ. (The driveway to the ESC School is directly opposite West Amwell Elementary School.) The \$50 fee includes all the supplies needed to complete a hooked project. Participants are requested to bring a 14” embroidery hoop and a pair of sharp scissors. Guild members Kay Weeks and Connie Coleman are the instructors. The workshop is limited to 10 participants.

The workshop will be held during the Guild’s annual week long rug hooking camp at the ESC School. After the workshop, participants are invited to observe Guild members working on their project with three nationally known camp instructors. Participants are also welcome to view an exhibit of rugs hooked by Guild members.
